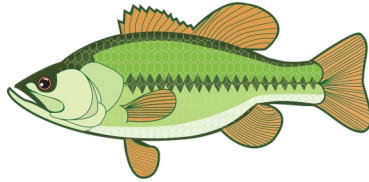


Free Fishing Weekend
