Reasons for tax increase if proposed exceeds the current:

General fund & Rural fund levy rate reduced in FY 2024-25 from current budget year of FY 2023-24 but tax dollars increased as valuations increased. The increased General Fund dollars are for salaries and insurance & increased rural fund tax dollars are for Secondary Roads use.
